Reporting to the Director of Supply Chain, the Planning Manager will be responsible for determining and setting manufacturing & production schedules, supply and demand planning and coordinating all outgoing order fulfillment with various departments. The Planning Manager ensures all direct and indirect materials are available in the supply chain and that inventory is maintained at acceptable levels.

- Lead, inspire, and support the demand planning team by validating and approving the supply needs of demand plans
- Prepare analyses for all products and review strategy with planners and purchasing
- Create and maintain all end to end operational plans for manufacturing and production.
- Establish and adjust safety stock levels for finished goods and raw material inventories
- Provide tactical volume, raw material requirements, and capacity analysis as needed
- Conduct long-term scenario planning
- Ensure that assumptions, risks, and opportunities relating to the short- and medium-term business targets are identified, monitored, and reported on
- Coordinate and communicate action plans to all departments
- Provide detailed weekly and monthly reporting on all areas of manufacturing and production
- Lead and drive cross functional meetings and initiatives
- Generate information on scheduled and independent demand items for use in the weekly and monthly leadership meetings
- Direct partner to Brand and Commercial in entering new market and new sku analysis
- Verify and maintain master data and planning parameters in the ERP
- Be a subject matter expert in the ERP
