- Reviewing and maintaining ongoing compliance requirements for security systems which may involve ongoing camera and motion sensor placement, reparations to security systems, and cleaning and servicing equipment.
- Participating in the maintenance of facility equipment.
- Occasional after hours and weekend work may be required with prior notice.
